

## Art Couture

說到法國巴黎，腦海不禁浮起艾菲爾鐵塔和凱旋門，這個項目身居巴黎中心地段，飽覽兩個世界名勝，大宅內部當然不能馬虎，必須要與其景觀相互平衡，設計師 Stephanie Coutas 以她的美學打造這個約 2,690 平方呎的大宅。Boasting spectacular views of the Mediterranean Sea, this luxurious 250 square metre penthouse in Paris perfectly exemplifies the ethos behind designer Stephanie Coutas' work, which positively oozes grace and sophistication.

**法** 國室內設計師 Stephanie Coutas 在亞洲長大，多元文化的生活體驗影響其風格。Stephanie Coutas 巧妙地融合浪漫主義和精美工藝，創造出許多令人驚嘆不已的新古典主義和現代室內設計，例如簡潔線條、壯麗裝飾、裸色調、獨特雲石和奢華的天鵝絨都是她的拿手好戲，這些都一一在這座由零開始的大宅完美展現。

**大宅氣勢**

改頭換面後的大宅比原先更好地運用大宅的美景優勢，設計師用上不同建材令整個大宅看起來更有氣勢。玄關牆身和地板都鋪上石灰華雲石 (Travertine Marble) 去塑造簡約的奢華感覺。用清鏡來裝飾可說是常見的手法，用「哈哈鏡」卻是鮮有的。玄關牆上的兩面「哈哈鏡」來頭不少，是 Christophe Gaignon mirrors，圓凸面型鑿琢水晶天花令空間更立體。橡木地板的色澤經由 SC Edition 根據場地所調配。擴闊客廳的空間絲毫沒浪費又非兩鐵者，和凱旋門美景。飯廳的酒吧滿足戶平時邀請親朋

好友到來，無論是晚宴或是隨和的派對都滿足其需要。玄關選用了「哈哈鏡」，這裡則選用一面等離大的清鏡。開放式廚房讓戶主可以一邊準備菜式，一邊和賓客交流，營造一個快活的聚會氛圍。廚房黑雲石中島的特別紋理相當顯眼，設計師特意用 Contardi Messalina 吊燈和白雲石廚房吧台來配襯這個性強烈的黑雲石。

**尊貴用料**

主人房以 PH Collection 床頭板和床邊櫃上 Gilles Caffier 床頭燈。房內的清鏡其實是部鏡面複氣機。衣帽間衣架和抽屜的木材非常罕見，這是珍貴的烏木木材，光滑的切面和細膩的木紋，令其在打磨後可達到鏡面般光亮，設計師再用拋光黃銅飾面，以配上黃銅飾面的支柱。浴室以 Fiore 雲石鋪設整個空間，意大利品牌 Devon&Devon Celine 浴缸的暖光面散發醇厚柔和感覺。浴室並不是方正間隔，設計師用一面玻璃牆分開淋浴空間，整體看起來有相當的空間感。
