

### Elegant harmony

### Timeless design

The villa showcases numerous rounded profiles and curved features, giving the interiors a timeless and elegant aesthetic.

**Originally built in the 1970s**, the home exemplifies a modern yet timeless design, merging indoor and outdoor living seamlessly. The spacious living room, dominated by large glass doors, opens onto an inviting outdoor lounge adjacent to a pristine swimming pool, allowing natural light to flood the interior. This setup not only enhances the elegant blend of vintage and modern décor but also creates a dynamic interaction with the villa's lush surroundings.

**Each room, including the six bedrooms and the kitchen, features expansive windows** that provide stunning views of the garden, distant hills, and the sea. Coutas' 'less-is-more' philosophy shines through the villa's interior with its neutral palette of sand, beige, and soft greens, punctuated by subtle accents of bright colors in the décor. The ground

floor hosts three guest rooms, each with a unique color theme, showcasing custom-made oak headboards and coordinated textiles. Coutas' attention to detail is evident in the unique furniture pieces she designed, inspired by the villa's natural setting and that can be seen at her gallery avenue Matignon in Paris.

**Outside, Stéphanie Coutas transformed the garden into a verdant oasis.** Strategic placement of cypress, olive, and pine trees crafts a scene that seems ageless, while the redesigned pool area now provides natural shade and privacy, enhancing the villa's luxurious feel. This St. Tropez villa, under Coutas' visionary design, celebrates a luxurious Mediterranean lifestyle, making every detail work in harmony to create a welcoming and timeless space.



### Sweet Dreams

The main bedroom showcases the 'Heloise' side table lamps, handcrafted from light beige sandstone by sculptor Hermine Bourdin, whose work draws inspiration from the female form. Both doors and cabinets are made in light oak wood and straw. All designed by Stéphanie Coutas interior design studio, in an atmosphere of peaceful and joyful feel.
